His dissertation research was focused on integrated watershed economic modeling for spatial targeting of conservation management options for reducing non-point source pollution load to water resources. He is trained to handle both biophysical and economic modeling. Before joining ORNL, he worked as a postdoctoral researcher at University of Tennessee for one year, where he conducted research on conservation prioritization in East Tennessee watersheds. He holds a BS in Agricultural Sciences and MS in Agricultural Economics from India. He also worked 5 years as an Agricultural Economist in an interdisciplinary research group in Indian Agricultural Research Institute, New Delhi, India, where he was involved in analysis of regional land use changes and its impact on regional food and environmental security.
