


Xiaojuan Yang

Xiaojuan Yang is a postdoctoral research associate in the Ecosystem Simulation Science group and the Climate Change Science Institute at ORNL. Her research interests consist of studying the interactions between terrestrial biogeochemical cycles and climate, the impacts of land-cover and land-use changes on climate, soil carbon sequestration in agricultural land, and integration of heterogeneous data and models.

Yang received her PhD in atmospheric sciences from the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign in 2009 where she also worked as a post-graduate research associate until beginning her tenure with ORNL.

Yang has been a referee for the domain journals *Global Change Biology* and *Climate Research* since 2009. She is a member of the American Geophysical Union (AGU), and in 2009 was co-chair for the AGU Biogeosciences Session: "Role of Climate Carbon, and Limiting Nutrient Cycles and Human Activities in the Terrestrial Ecosystems."
