


Shishi Liu

Shishi Liu is a postdoctoral research associate with the Distributed Active Archive Center at ORNL.

She recently received her PhD in Geography from the University of California, Santa Barbara. Shishi works on the North American Carbon Program using output from a number of advanced models to understand the fluxes and stocks of carbon in the biosphere. Shishi works with a multi-institutional team that is evaluating a dozen terrestrial biosphere models and how well they estimate observed fluxes and carbon inventories.

Liu received her PhD in geography from the University of California—Santa Barbara. Her dissertation was titled *The Impacts of Soil Moisture on Different Plant Functional Types in California*. While at UC-Santa Barbara, Liu was a teaching assistant for both the Environmental Studies and Geography departments. Her BE is in remote sensing and information engineering from Wuhan University in China.
